Goal:

EQUIP Team Meetings:

The EQUIP team will meet twice a month where we will have a chance to learn leadership skills through a time of teaching and interaction in small groups. Students will also break into student led ministry teams where students will plan and implement the responsibilities of their teams. The EQUIP team will only meet during the school year and will not meet during the summer.

EQUIP Leadership Retreat: "Foundations of a Leader"

During the FALL semester students will be taken away on a ministry weekend where they will be challenged to grow deeper in their faith and in their service to Christ. At this retreat they will learn the basic foundations what it means to be a leader. It will be a time of special time with the Lord, teaching, group games, and most likely a whole lot of fun.

Connection Team
